

## **FAA James Scholar Project Grants**

The purpose of the James Scholar Project Grant Program is to support outstanding James Scholars in their pursuit of special projects, research, and/or travel associated with such activities. All students participating in the FAA James Scholar Program are invited to apply.

Applicants are asked to provide the following information:

- In 500 words or less, provide a description or abstract of your project. Please include information about the significance of this project to a broader audience and the specific methods you will use to carry it.
- In an additional 500 words or less, tell us why your project should be funded by the FAA James Scholar Project Grant Program. Explain how your project would be enriched by the award and what the award would support you to do (i.e., purchase research supplies, travel to present or perform your work, execute research, etc.). If you request a travel award, include the details of your travel plan. Requests for travel to participate in a conference are welcome, but travel should relate to the current semester.
- Have you received James Scholar Research or Project Support in the past? If so, how was it used, and why should a second award be funded?
- Provide an itemized budget of how the funds will be used. For research support, include costs of professional supplies (not books), equipment, and reproduction. For travel awards, include costs of transportation and accommodations. Also, please indicate (1) any other funding you may be receiving, (2) how costs exceeding the award will be covered.
- Please attach a resume that includes work experience, campus and community activities, and university honors and awards.

Award cycles occur for fall and spring. The deadline for the fall 2016 cycle is Friday, October 7, 2016 at 11:59 p.m. Please complete an online application at <https://illinois.edu/sb/sec/6683558>.
